



SR.NEG.SHARE

Overview

The subroutine SR.NEG.SHARE is designed to be called from a dictionary. The account number is passed to the subroutine and it returns the number of days negative. If the account just went negative that day it returns 0, if the account isn't negative it returns null, if the account has been negative since the oldest transaction on the account it returns the number days since that transaction.

Installation

Copy the file SR.NEG.SHARE into your test or live account under the BP directory.

Make sure the file has read permission.

At the MESA prompt type: BASIC BP SR.NEG.SHARE
The BASIC command compiles the source code.

Then type: CATALOG BP SR.NEG.SHARE
The CATALOG command makes it usable in a dictionary.

Use

This is a sample dictionary to use it in. This sample is setup to be used in a file that has the account id as the key (i.e. TRAN and ACCOUNT).

Top of "US_DAYS.NEG" in "DICT ACCOUNT", 6 lines, 36 characters.

If you edit the source code in a program that automatically adds ^013 line feeds make sure to remove them. If you try to compile it with those you will get syntax errors.
